As an ex-technology consultant for TTP, he has worked with many leading UK and American brands, small and medium sized businesses helping them to turn science into new products. Significant projects he worked on included: nano-structured coatings for spectacles and sunglasses, electronically switchable contact lenses, laser machined razor blades, and mechanical skin modelling for novel drug delivery systems.

Richard is now Lead Technologist for Innovate UK: a non-departmental government body sponsored by the Department of Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy. His goal is to identify big shifts in science and technology which will transform our lives in 10 or more years from now, and to support companies in these emerging areas.

Richard's main responsibility is to help generate company support within the UK quantum technologies programme, to help companies understand and develop commercial uses for quantum technologies and to help these companies to be at the forefront of what will be a large global industry, Richard co-authored the UK [strategy](#) and [roadmap](#), the UK Government office for science 'Blackett review' and European [manifesto](#) for quantum technologies.
